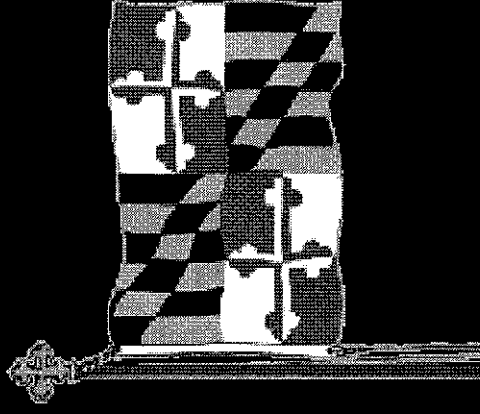
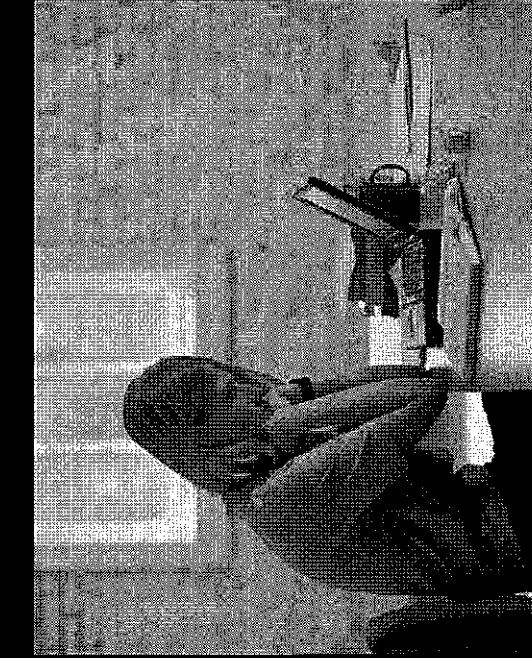

To see if your HCC class transfers to your 4 year college...

1. Click on "Course Equivalencies".
2. HCC is the sending institution...and the school you are transferring to is the receiving institution.
3. Click on the icon that says lookup course. It will tell you if the receiving institution accepts the course and if so what it will count as toward your 4 year degree.
4. Type in the HCC course ID number: (example for Biology 101 use BIO 101) then click on "Go".

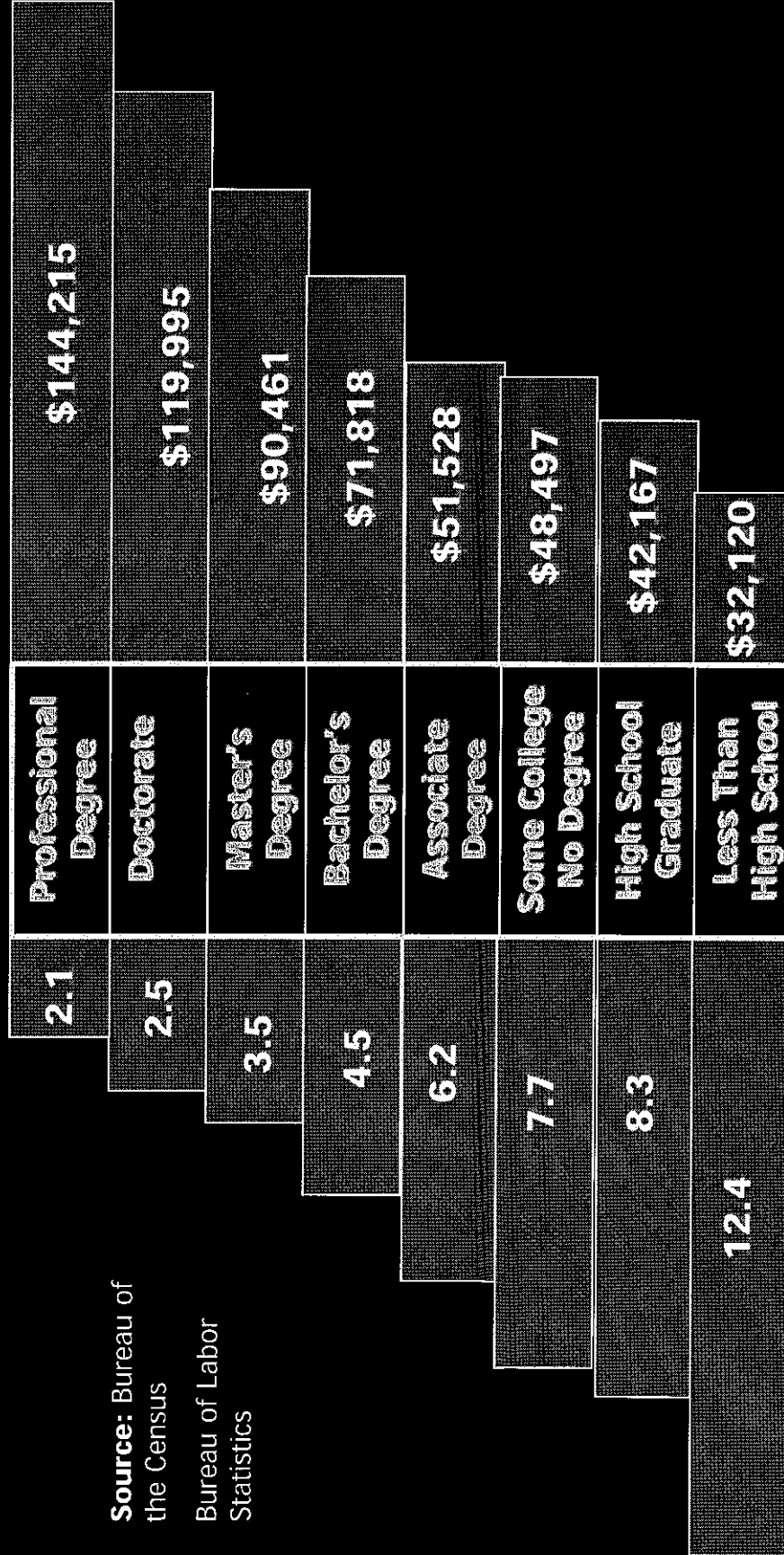
To see what classes your 4 year school recommends you take at HCC...

1. Click on "Recommended Transfer Program".
2. HCC is the sending institution; the school you are transferring to is the receiving institution.
3. Click on "Show RTP's" – this provides a list of majors you can choose from.
4. Click on the major you choose and look for the most recent information and classes to choose from at HCC.
