


- HCC is the sending institution...and the school you are transferring to is the receiving institution. 2.
- Click on the icon that says lookup course. It will tell you if the receiving institution accepts the course and if so what it will count as toward your 4 year degree. 3.
- Type in the HCC course ID number: (example for Biology 101 use BiO 101) then click on "Go". 4.

- . Click on "Recommended Transfer Program".
